I understand that writing a bad check is a criminal act and doing so may subject me to criminal action in accordance to section 4105 Pennsylvania State Law.

## Summary Grading of Pennsylvania Bad Check Law

- 1. An offense under section 4105 is:
  - i. a summary offense if the check or order is less than \$200; result fine up to \$300.00 and or imprisonment not more than 90 days.
  - ii. a misdemeanor of the third degree if the check or order is \$200 or more but less than \$500; result fine up to \$2,500.00 and or imprisonment not more than 1 year.
  - iii. a misdemeanor of the second degree if the check or order is \$500 or more but less than \$1,000; result fine up to \$5,000.00 and or imprisonment not more than 2 years.
  - iv. a misdemeanor of the first degree if the check or order is \$1,000 or more but is less than \$75,000; result fine up to \$10,000.00 and or imprisonment not more than 5 years.
  - v. a felony of the third degree if the check or order is \$75,000 or more; result fine up to \$150,000.00 and or imprisonment not more than 7 year.
- 2. When the offense is a third or subsequent offense within a five-year period, regardless of the amount of the check or order and regardless of the grading of the prior offenses, an offense under this section is a misdemeanor of the first degree unless the amount of the check or order involved in the third or subsequent offense is \$75,000 or more, then the offense is a felony of the third degree.
